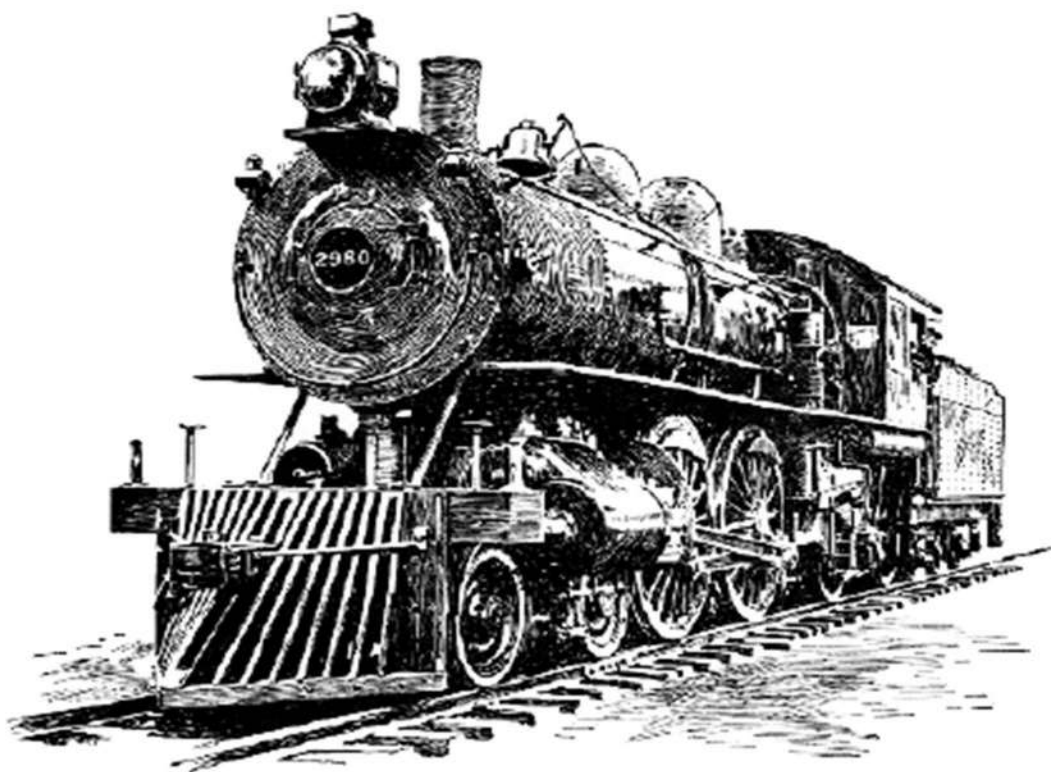




TRAIN JOURNEY

On the contrary many travel through the glamorous broad way. But it is full of sin, selfishness and lustful pleasures. It ends up in destruction (Matthew 7:13, 14).
